Scripture Study Journey **The Gospel of Matthew**

Matthew: the King and His Kingdom is an exciting study that explores the life and mission of Jesus as recorded in the Gospel. Matthew demonstrates how the promises and the prophecies of the Old Testament are fulfilled in Christ, who establishes a New Law and inaugurates the Kingdom of Heaven on earth. Participants will see Jesus as the awaited Messiah who relives the life and struggles of Israel to become the faithful and victorious King. Set in the rich context of Jewish culture, this study will help participants understand who Jesus is and what his life and teachings mean for us today. In addition participants will also:

- see Jesus as the son of David, the son of Abraham, the New Moses, the True Manna, the New Temple and learn what this means for us today
- learn how Jesus reconstituted Israel around Himself and opened the Kingdom of God to all people
- witness how Christ established His Church with the 12 Apostles and Peter as His vicar
- rediscover the roots of the sacraments and see how Jesus' words and actions are reflected in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass
- watch Jesus re-live the history of Israel as the obedient Son who trusts the Father, defeats hell and the grave and rises to new life
